SUPPLEMENTAL SCHEDULING ORDER

As directed by this Court's Scheduling Order of January 22, 2010, which was docketed January 23, 2010, the parties have conferred concerning the scheduling of events with respect to defendant National Arbitration Forum ("NAF"). As a result of those discussions, the parties have submitted an agreed proposed schedule with respect to NAF, which the Court has reviewed. NAF joined this case as a defendant in June, 2009, long after the action commenced against the other defendants. NAF intends to conduct discovery to support its opposition to class certification. The proposed schedule substantially aligns the deadlines with respect to NAF with those applicable to the other defendants in this action. Defendants other than NAF consent to the proposed schedule. Therefore, the Court sets the following deadlines with respect to proceedings regarding NAF:

1. Fact discovery between Class Plaintiffs and NAF shall be completed by June 18, 2010.
2. With respect to class certification, NAF shall submit its opposition to class certification on or before May 28, 2010, and Class Plaintiffs shall reply on or before July 2, 2010.
3. The due dates stated in Paragraphs 2, 3, and 4 of this Court's Scheduling Order, docketed January 23, 2010, shall apply fully with respect to NAF as with respect to the other parties to this action.
